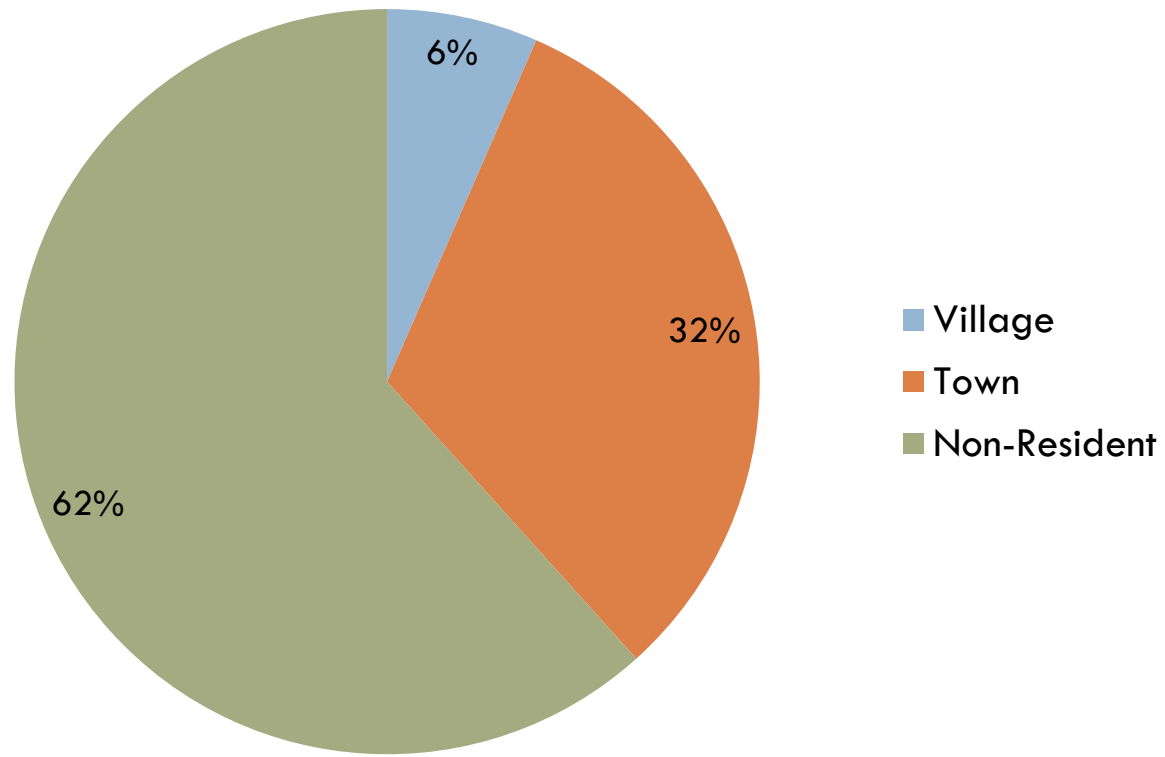

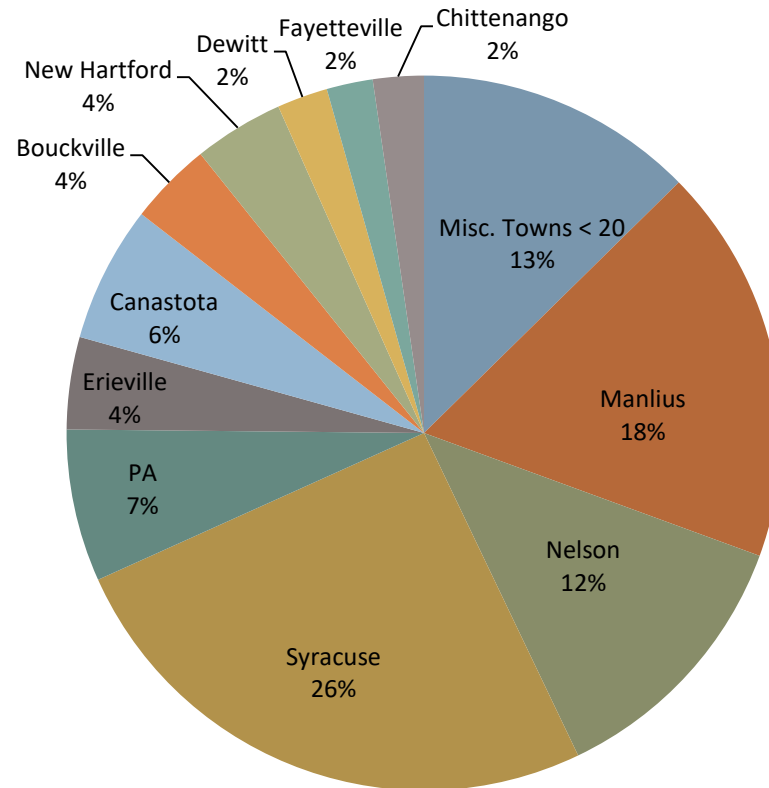
2019 Boat Launch Stats

- 1677 inspections, 3 fewer than last year
- Usage patterns about the same as last year
- Passes
 - 383 Resident (Free)
 - 203 Non-Resident (\$75/\$40) 13 more than last year
 - 71 Daily Passes (\$10, Tues-Thurs) 4 more than last year

2019 Boat Launch Usage by Out of Town Residents



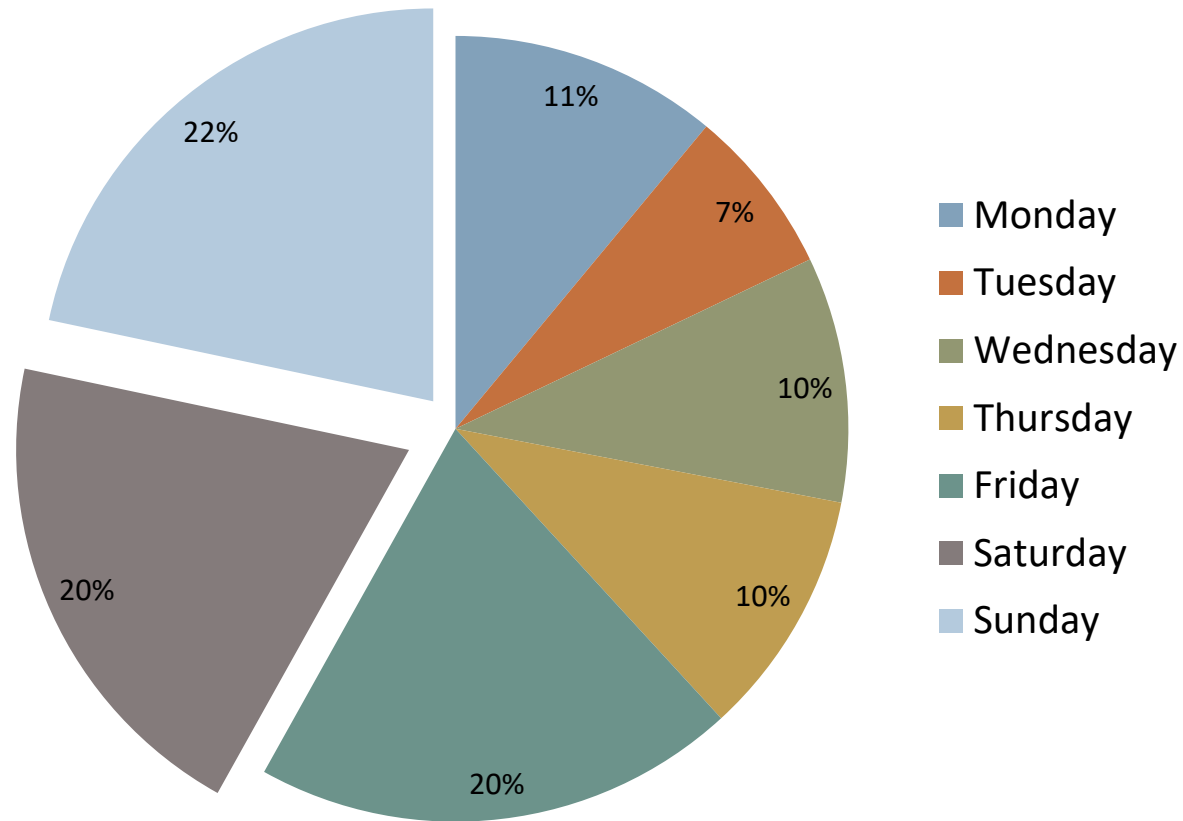
Last Body of Water Visited

Most Frequent Bodies of Water Last Visited 2019

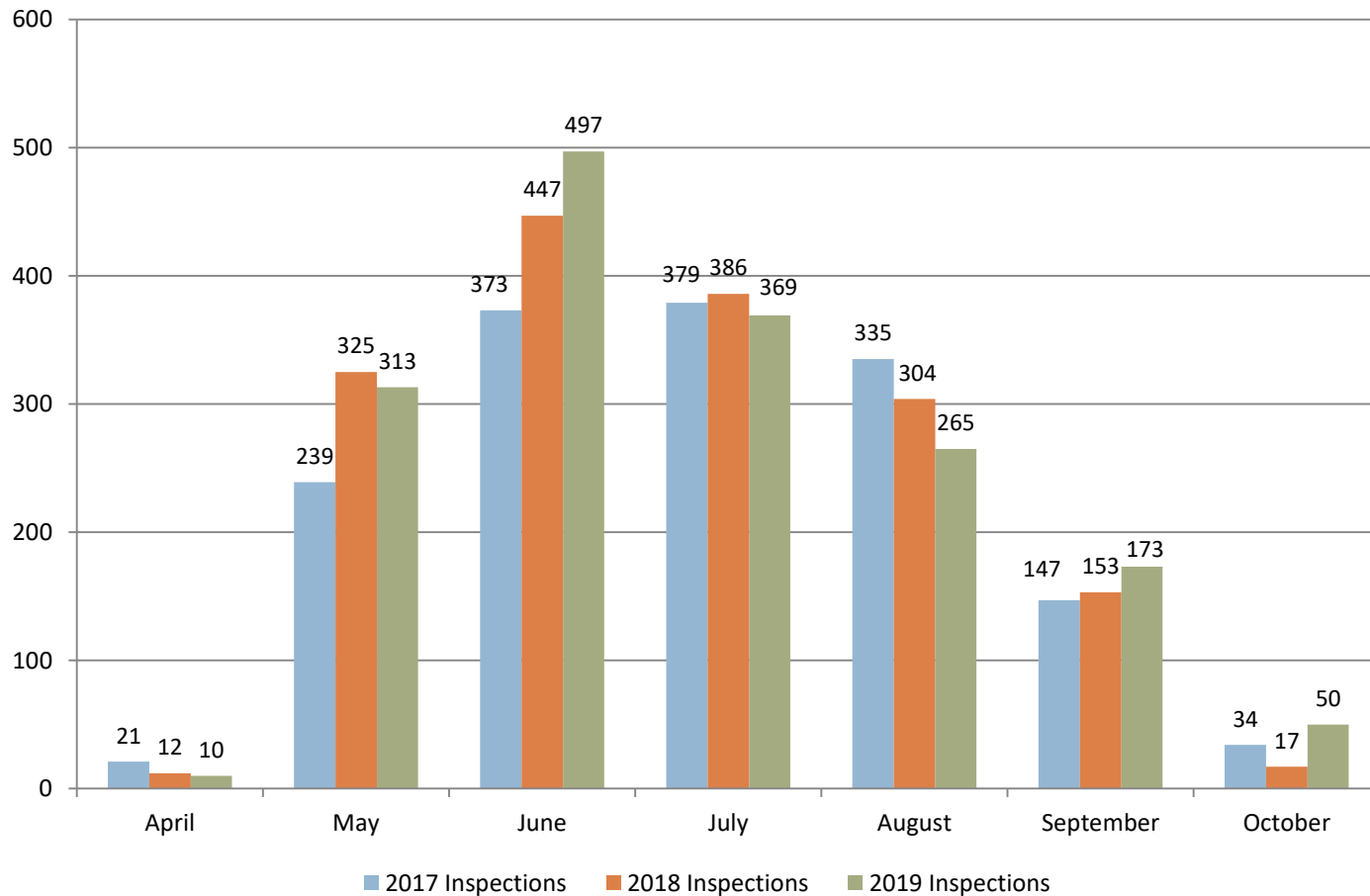
Body of Water	Entries to Caz Lake

- 2 Canadian Provinces and 5 states

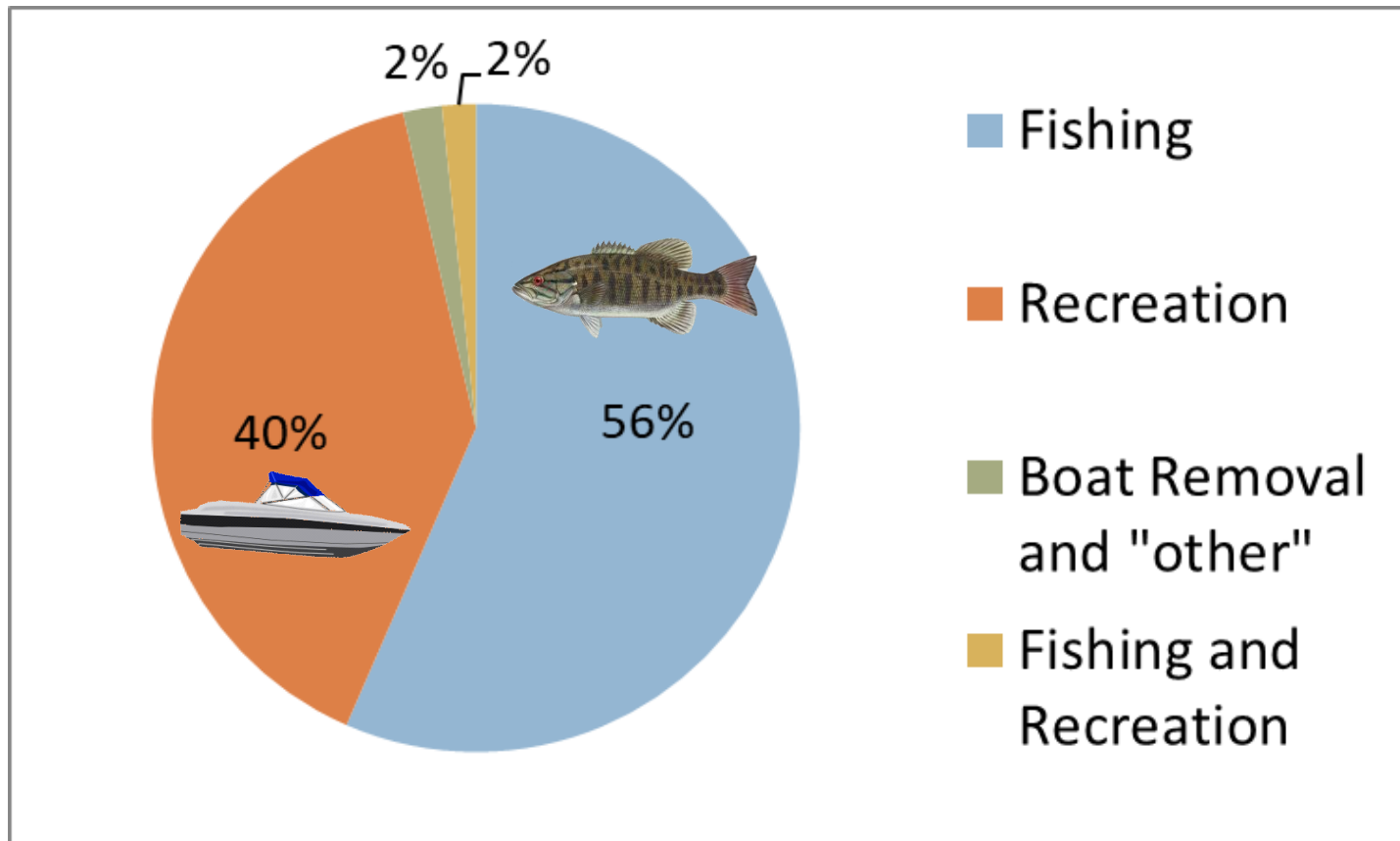
2019 Boat Launch Usage by Day of Week



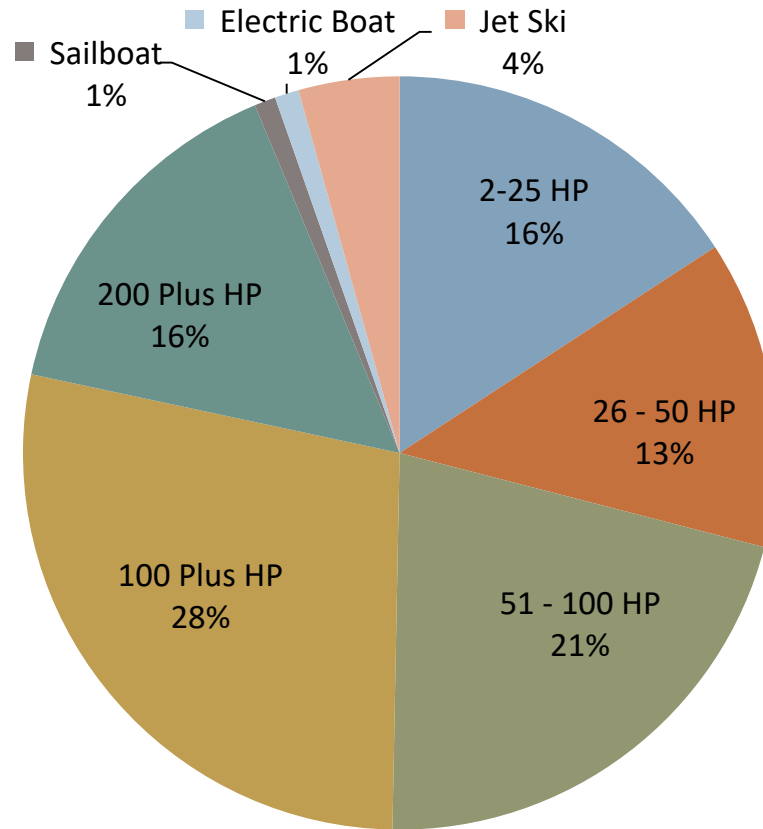
Inspections by Month 2017 - 2019
