VILLAGE OF CAZENOVIA BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS

Bid instructions for bids for the roof replacement of the Village of South Village Sidewalk Project:

- (1) ALL BIDS SHALL BE BINDING FOR 30 DAYS SUBSEQUENT TO DATE OF BID OPENING, AND MAY NOT BE WITHDRAWN DURING SUCH TIME PERIOD.
- (2) BID OPENING: BIDS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE VILLAGE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF CAZENOVIA, VILLAGE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 90 ALBANY STREET, CAZENOVIA, NEW YORK NO LATER THAN 3:00 P.M. ON MAY 28, 2020, AND SHALL BE OPENED BY THE CLERK AND READ ALOUD AT SUCH PLACE AND TIME. NO LATE BIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

GENERAL CONDITIONS VILLAGE OF CAZENOVIA SOUTH VILLAGE SIDEWALK PROJECT

INTENT:

It is the intent of the bid proposal to solicit bids for materials, labor, and related services to excavate and install approximately 750 feet of new ADA compliant sidewalk in the South Village area of the **Village of Cazenovia.** The successful bidder will furnish all materials, labor and equipment to complete the Project.

SPECIFICATIONS AND CONDITIONS

1. BIDDER EXPERIENCE:

Bids will only be considered from companies which have an established reputation in the field. All bidders shall submit information describing the company's history and experience with sidewalk construction.

2. MATERIALS AND WORKMANSHIP:

All materials and workmanship shall be in accordance with generally accepted installation and construction standards as well as the referenced NYSDOT and ADA specifications and shall include and comply with the following conditions:

Work Includes – all materials, equipment and labor for:

- Contact DSNY for utility location
- Coordination of layout with the Village
- Establishment of staging area and equipment storage area. No materials or equipment may be stored outside permissible working hours on South Village Drive. Storage location(s) must be approved by the Village.
- Topsoil, and subsoil removal to acceptable subgrade conditions with offsite disposal
- Providing concrete washout area
- Compaction of subgrade
- Installation and compaction of granular base material
- Construction of five-foot wide ADA compliant concrete sidewalk in accordance with NYSDOT and Village of Cazenovia sidewalk specifications with up to two detectable warning pads at intersection aprons
- Sidewalks to be installed within the Village street lines a minimum of four (4) feet from the edge of pavement. Specific alignment and any deviations are subject to Village approval
- Protection of sidewalk from damage/vandalism/extreme weather during curing

- Providing traffic control during construction and maintain one-way traffic at all times on South Village Drive, and two-way traffic after 5:00 PM until 7:00 AM weekdays, and all weekends.
- Working hours are limited to 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM weekdays
- Maintain driveway access for all properties
- Topsoil and seed all disturbed lawn areas
- In-kind restoration of all other disturbed surfaces
- One-year bond and guarantee
- Daily street sweeping

3. TIME OF COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION OF WORK:

- a. Work covered by this contract shall be completed within thirty (30) days of commencement of construction. All Work covered by this contract shall be completed by **September 30, 2020.**
- b. If said contractor shall neglect, fail or refuse to complete the work by the date herein specified said contractor does hereby agree to pay the **Village of Cazenovia** liquidated damages totaling one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per calendar day for each and every calendar day the contractor shall be in default of the completion date stipulated in the contract.
- c. The successful bidder must comply with the current wage rate schedule and all other requirements as determined by the New York State Department of Labor. Certified Payroll Affidavits are to be submitted to the Village of Cazenovia Department of Public Works. It is expected that all work performed under this proposal shall be accomplished Monday through Friday. The Public Works Administrator for the Village of Cazenovia must approve any exceptions to this.

4. PREP WORK:

The **Contractor** shall be responsible for all mobilization costs, prep work, and removal of existing materials.

5. RAIN DELAY:

The Contractor shall take into account as an anticipated condition that work may be stopped or delayed on certain days in the event of rain or other unfavorable weather conditions.

6. BIDDING PROCEDURE:

The award for the contract will be made on the **Village of Cazenovia's** consideration of the lowest unit bid price and the bidder's specified work completion date. The **Village of Cazenovia** reserves the right to reject the lowest bid price in favor of an earlier work completion date if it determines that will result in the best value for the Village. The **Village of Cazenovia** reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

7. DEFECTS:

For a period of one (1) year from the date of the completion of work, the successful bidder, at its own cost and expense, shall remedy and correct any defects and conditions not complying with the

specifications described herein, when such defects and conditions are the result of materials and/or workmanship not meeting the specifications of this proposal.

8. INSURANCE:

The Contract shall indemnify and save harmless the Village against all loss, cost or damage on account of injury (including death) to persons or property occurring in the performance of the contract together with any and all attorney's fees incurred by the Village on account of any thereof. The Contractor shall, at its own cost and expense, provide and maintain insurance coverage (with insurance companies licensed to transact business in New York State) in full force and effect throughout the period covered by these specifications as follows:

- a. Comprehensive General Liability, including premises operations, personal injury, contractual liability, independent contractors and completed operations:
 - (i) Property damage in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.
 - (ii) Bodily injury in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- Comprehensive Automobile Liability, including non-ownership and hired car coverage as well as owned vehicle coverage (with necessary endorsements for compliance with the Motor Carrier Act of 1980):
 - (i) Bodily injury and property damage combined single limit of liability not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- c. Not less than \$2,000,000 umbrella coverage.
- d. Worker's Compensation Insurance for its employees and others who might be covered by such insurance statutory limits.
- e. Disability Benefit Insurance statutory limits.


All above insurance shall be written to include the Village of Cazenovia as an additional insured (except as to Worker's Compensation Insurance and Disability Benefit Insurance) which must be primary and noncontributory and provide for notice of termination or cancellation to be given to the Village at least 30 days prior to the effective date of any such termination or cancellation. The Contractor shall provide the Village with valid certificates of insurance, or other evidence satisfactory to the Village that all such insurance is in force and that all premiums due thereon have been duly paid for all such coverage prior to the performance of any services under the contract.

9. NON-COLLUSION BIDDING CERTIFICATE:

All bidders are required to sign the "Non-Collusion Bidding Certificate" and submit it as part of the bid.

10. CONTRACT PAYMENT TERMS:

Payment of the Contract Price will be made in full upon completion of the work subject to retainage in the amount of 5% of the contract price pending expiration of the one (1) year materials and workmanship guarantee period. The Village reserves the right to make partial payment(s) and to withhold payment for uncompleted and/or unsatisfactory work.






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




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DETAIL: HANDICAP CURB RAMP





DETAILS

Village of Cazenovia, NY Saturday, May 4, 2019

Chapter 152. Streets and Sidewalks

Article III. Street and Sidewalk Construction Standards

§ 152-15. Sidewalk design and construction standards.

Sidewalks shall be installed in accordance with Details 4 and 5 set forth at the end of this chapter and the following specifications:

- A. Sidewalks shall be constructed of 4,000 psi fiber mesh reinforced concrete to dimensions and locations specified by the Village. The maximum size of course aggregate shall be 1 1/2 inch. Concrete shall have a slump of between 1 1/2 and four inches. The concrete mixtures shall have air content by volume of concrete, based on measurements made immediately after discharge from the mixer of 5% to 7%. Air content shall be determined in accordance with ASTM C 231. Compounds containing calcium chloride shall not be used.
- B. Sidewalks shall be four inches thick and reinforced with fiber mesh at all locations, except in driveways where the depth will be six inches.
- C. Special care must be given to see that fiber mesh is fully incorporated into concrete prior to placement.
- D. Fiber mesh found not to be incorporated at time of placement may cause rejection of the entire concrete load.
- E. Concrete after placement that is found to have pockets of fiber mesh may cause the contractor to remove and replace concrete at the contractor's expense.
- F. Subgrade shall be maintained in a smooth, compacted condition in conformity with required section and established grade until concrete is in place. Subgrades and forms shall be wet down sufficiently in advance of the placing of concrete to insure a firm and moist condition.
- G. Sidewalks shall be grooved at right angles to sidewalks at intervals equal to width of sidewalks, unless otherwise specified, and shall also be constructed in accordance with the following standards:
 - (1) The control joint groove depth will not exceed 25% of the walk thickness.
 - (2) One-half-inch preformed bituminous expansion shall be installed where sidewalks abut against curbing or other concrete construction.
 - (3) Expansion joints shall be installed in a straight run of sidewalks at intervals of not more than 20 feet.
 - (4) Joint material shall extend from a level 1/4 inch below the surface of the sidewalk to the underside of concrete.
 - (5) Village standard sidewalk dimensions are five feet wide with scored five-foot modules.

- H. Sidewalks shall have a brushed surface perpendicular to direction of travel.
- I. Dusting to absorb surface water will not be permitted.
- J. Joints and edges shall be rounded with an approved edging tool.
- K. All concrete must be protected until fully cured. Damaged section(s) must be replaced if vandalism occurs during the curing process.
- L. All new Village streets shall include a pedestrian sidewalk on at least one side of the street. All sidewalks shall comply with the most current version of ADA standards, with a maximum sustained (>30 feet) slope of 5%. No sidewalk ramp slope will exceed 8%, except for non-traveled curb cut wings (maximum 10%). Sidewalk cross slopes will not exceed 2%. Minimum sidewalk width for new sidewalks shall be five feet.
